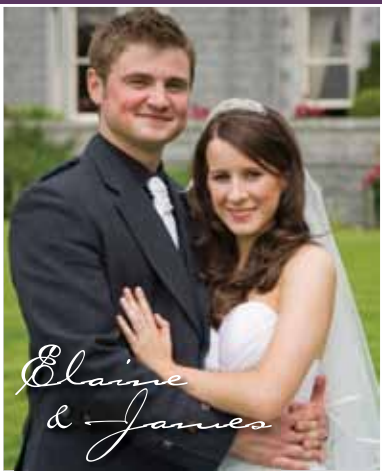
How did you feel walking down the aisle?
